Method





This experienced by non-English study program students. One of them is a student of the Islamic Communication Broadcasting Study Program (KPI Study Program), Faculty of Da'wah and Islamic Communication, Kudus State Islamic Institute.

In Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka (MBKM) curriculum of KPI study program IAIN Kudus, it is stated that KPI study program has three graduate profiles, namely Islamic communication and broadcasting practitioners, research assistants developers of Islamic communications, and broadcasting and media policy advocacy. In KPI curriculum, learning is adapted to create students profiles that gain insight and related Islamic experience to communication and broadcasting. Based on interviews with KPI students, they hope that the English they learn will also support their scientific background and graduate profiles.

Different types of blended learning models, such as face-to-face or online driver models, rotation models, enriched virtual learning models, flex learning, or self-blend learning, can be created based on the various ways in which we can combine the learning modes. The idea behind almost all of these models is the same: they combine instructor-assisted learning with online learning. However, the proportions of time that learners spend in each setting change depending on their learning needs.

Here are a few typical methods for delivering hybrid public speaking model:

Rotation Model - In this paradigm, the students alternate between instructor-assisted learning (discussions, activities, exams) and technology-assisted self-learning. The students either begin their own study at the computer station before moving to the teacher's desk or classroom, or the other way around.

Enriched Virtual Model – In this model, the students receive one-to-one session with the instructor and complete rest of the curriculum independently on their own.

Face-to-face/Online Driver Model: Face-to-Face/Online - In the face-to-face approach, the instructor covers the majority of the curriculum and directs the students to online learning resources for additional study. In the online driver model, students self-learn the majority of the curriculum and only contact the instructor when necessary or required by the program. Self-blend learning is another blended learning method that is comparable to in-person or online driver models.

Flex Learning Model - The majority of the learning is likewise done online under this paradigm, but students are still under the teacher's supervision. Through individual counseling or group sessions, the teachers offer timely help. In higher secondary education, the Flex learning paradigm is extremely well-liked.

Flipped Classroom Learning Model - In a flipped classroom learning model, the students complete their homework at home by watching online videos or taking online courses depending on the curriculum. They engage in group discussions or other

learning activities in the classroom with their classmates and a teacher present to guide them.

Project Based Learning Model – This is used to finish a specific learning project. The students use online study portals that are either self-directed or assisted, and they receive project guidance from the teacher (personal counseling or collaboration). The project could consist of learning tasks, learning materials, or learning artifacts.

Inside-Out/Outside-In learning model: In the inside-out learning model, students are taught in the classroom and then taken outside to further their learning in real or virtual communities or social groups. In the Outside-In learning approach, students begin their learning experiences outside of the classroom and complete them there, where they collaborate and receive and give feedback.

Conclusion

Several method to succeed hybrid public speaking are face to face, personalization, blended learning, adaptive learning tools, social distancing, flexible schedules, remote learning.

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
