## 1.2. The Role of Parents in Religious Education

Parents play an important role in guiding and directing children to explore the faith. The role of parents in religious education is in the form of providing a good example of the power of faith in God in the family.

Based on the researchers' observations, parents do not accept children who have not performed prayers, salaries, and studied at the landfill. Parents are busy with their work and some are even fun playing mobile phones. From the explanation above, it can be seen that the role of parents in children's faith education has not been carried out properly, children still often do not carry out prayers and prayers in landfills (Juwariyah, 2010).

### 1.3. The Role of Parents in Moral Education
