Notonegoro mentions, social values are divided into three: Material values, namely everything that is useful for the physical elements of humans, such as food, water, or clothing. Vital values, namely everything that is useful for humans to carry out activities and activities. Spiritual values, namely everything that is useful for the human mind or spirituality (Notonegoro in Ahmad Risdi, 2019).

#### 2. Research Methods

The method used in this study is a qualitative research method, namely a research method carried out in an effort to present the social world and its perspective in the world in terms of concepts, behavior, and human problems studied (Lexy J. "If several years ago Master came to my hometown by bus, Master would have stopped near the market. Then about a kilometer from the market, you will arrive at my village road. At the small intersection to the right, the fifth intersection, turn onto the narrow road. And at the end of the road you will meet an old surau. In front of it is a fish pond, the water of which flows through four showers."

From the quote above, there is a material value, namely something that is useful for grandfather's life, namely the old surau, which grandfather used as a placeto live.

#### 3.2. Vital Value

Vital value is a value that exists because of its use, for example a knife. Knives have a certain price or value because of their sharpness that can be used to cut something, but if this knife is blunt, its value will decrease. Vital values are everything that is useful for humans in carrying out various activities in meeting their needs, for example: expertise and knowledge, vehicles, telecommunication facilities (Notonegoro in Ahmad Risdi, 2012). The following excerpts indicate material values:

"But as a garin he is not very well known. He is better known as a knife sharpener. Because he is so good at his job."

From the quote above, there is a vital value, namely grandfather's expertise in sharpening knives as one of grandfather's efforts to fulfill his life needs.

#### 3.3. Spiritual Value

Spiritual values are values that exist in the human psyche which consist of aesthetic values, moral values, religious values and scientific or logical truth values. Spiritual values are everything that is useful for human spiritual needs, for example: Pancasila values, Religion and Views Human life (Notonegoro in Ahmad Risdi, 2012). The following is a quote that shows the value of spirituality/spiritual:

"And in the left courtyard of the surau, you will meet an old man who usually sits there with all his old behavior and obedience to worship. He had been Garin, the surau guard for many years. People call him Grandpa."

From the quote above, there is a spiritual value, namely grandfather's obedience in worship.

In another quote it is stated:

"People like to ask him for help, while he never asks for anything in return. Women who ask for help sharpen knives or scissors, give him chili in return. Men who ask for help, give him cigarettes in exchange, sometimes money. But what he receives most often is a thank you and a little smile."

From the quote above, there is a moral value, where grandfather often gets rewarded after he helps people, here it is seen that people's awareness that life requires empathy. Also, although grandfather often gets a reward in the form of gratitude and a smile, he still helps people. In another quote it is also mentioned:

"Angry? Yes, if I was young, but I'm old. Parents hold variety. I haven't been angry in a long time. I'm afraid that if my faith is damaged because of it, my worship will be damaged because of it. For so long I have done good, worshiped, put my trust in God. It's been so long since I surrendered myself to Him. And God will love those who are patient and trusting."

From the quote above, there are religious values, where grandfather keeps his faith and worship so as not to be damaged, and also does good and trusts. In another quote it is explained:

Like everyone else, you know? I don't think about my own life. I don't want to findrich, build a house. All my life, physically and mentally, I surrender to Allah Subhanahu wataala. I have never troubled other people. A fly refuses me to kill it. But now I'm said to be a cursed human. Hell bait. Would God be mad if that was what I did, you think? Will he curse me if all my life I serve Him? I don't think about my tomorrow, because I believe that God exists and is compassionate and merciful to his people who are trusting. I wake up early. I wash. I beat the drum to wake people from their sleep, so thatbow down to Him. I pray all the time. I praise Him. I read His book. Alhamdulillah I said when I received His gift. Astagfirullah I said when I was surprised. Masha Allah I said when I was amazed. What's wrong with my job? But now I'm said to be a cursed human."

From the quote above, there are religious values, namely surrendering one's life to Allah, and trying to carry out His commands and stay away from His prohibitions.

From the quote above, there is a religious value, namely Haji pious who tried to carryout Hiscommands, namely worshiping Him, chanting His name.
